I am a PhD candidate in Economics at the University of Siena with a passion for exploring unexplored and challenging topics. My research combines my background in history, advanced training in economics, and a strong interest in programming, allowing me to approach problems with a creative and multidisciplinary perspective. I have reconstructed GDP at the provincial level for Italy between 1871–1911 and 1951–1991, investigated the relationship between early childcare and female labour participation rates, and analysed energy consumption trends in Italy to attempt one of the first calculations of the informal economy in economic history. Throughout my career, I have developed advanced skills in Python, R, QGIS, and OCR technologies.
